#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES**

Students will prepare and present course materials under supervision of course director.

**Pre-requisites** – None

**Semester credit hours** – 1-2 credit hours depending on the number of lectures given by the student. Two credits hours are required by doctoral students to fulfill their requirements.

By the end of this course, each student should be able to:

- Plan and organize lectures
- Successfully instruct students on relevant topics
- Orally communicate their lecture material effectively
- Prepare exam question and critically evaluate student's performance

#### **COURSE ORGANIZATION**

**The student will identify courses they are interested in conducting their supervised teaching. The student must request permission to do their supervised teaching from the course director. The student and course director must agree on the lectures or laboratories to be taught. The student must prepare a written summary to Dr. Geoffrey Clarke for approval prior to enrolling in Supervised Teaching.**

**Materials** – Equipment and supplies required for their lectures will be based on individual student's needs.

**Computer Access** – The student must have access to a computer to prepare their lectures/laboratory handouts.

**Reading Assignments** – Assignments will be suggested by the faculty.
