Course description and Overall Goals: This course is intended to teach residents to diagnose oral disease of endodontic origin and provide satisfactory non-surgical and surgical treatment of endodontic disease.

Student's evaluation: Class attendance and participation during discussions related to the themes are extremely important to this course and will be taken into the consideration of the student's performance. The authority of discerning will also be used to evaluate the student.

Grading policy: Grades will be determined by attendance and participation in class discussions. Letters grades will be given based on grading scale of 90-100 = A; 80-89 = B, 70-79 = C; 65-69 = D; 0-64 =F.
