

Syllabus
IBMS 7099 – Dissertation

This course is designed to allow graduate students time to write their doctoral dissertations, and to receive guidance from their Dissertation Supervising Committees. Registration in IBMS 7099 is only permitted following a student's admission to candidacy for the Ph.D. degree, approval of the dissertation research proposal and approval of the membership of the candidate's Dissertation Supervising Committee. A candidate for the Ph.D. degree must register for the Dissertation course for at least two semesters. Students should enroll in the research course section that corresponds to the most appropriate IBMS discipline: IBMS Disciplines: IBMS 7099-2BA for Biology of Aging (BA), IBMS 7099-3CB for Cancer Biology (CB), IBMS 7099-4CGM for Cell Biology, Genetics & Molecular Medicine (CGM), IBMS 7099-5III for Infections, Inflammation & Immunity (III), 7099-6MBB for Molecular Biophysics & Biochemistry (MBB), IBMS 7099-6NS for Neuroscience (NS), and IBMS 7099-7PP for Physiology & Pharmacology (PP).
